

Keeping it Honest: Vulnerable Writing

Venue

The conference venue is situated at the English Park Campus, the Centre for the Humanities at Uppsala University. English Park Campus is a 10-15 minutes' walk from the city centre and the central train station. There are also buses departing from Stora Torget toward Slottsbacken that will take you to campus (no 2, 7, 11). The bus stop "Slottsbacken" is right next to the university library Carolina Rediviva. A quick walk through the park behind the library will take you to campus. Bus tickets can be bought from the driver or at the UL-office at the central train station or from vending machines (there is one at Stora Torget).

Traveling to Uppsala

Arlanda is the closest airport. There's a train station at the airport in terminal 5, Sky City, where tickets can be bought. Two different train services and one coach service run between Arlanda and Uppsala. The fastest option is to take a train. A journey with SL to Uppsala takes about 18 minutes. The national train company- SJ – also has departures from Arlanda at a somewhat lower price. The local bus company, UL, offers a bus service from the airport to Uppsala (bus number 801). The ride takes 45 minutes. Tickets can be bought on the bus (most credit cards are accepted).

Hotels

All hotels that are situated right in the city centre are at a convenient distance from the conference venue (10-20 min walk). We recommend Akademihotellet which is located only a few hundred meters from the English Park Campus. Uppsala CityStay Hotel is a budget alternative that is conveniently located. We also warmly recommend Grand Hotel Hörnan located in the city centre by the Fyris River at a 10 minutes walk from the conference venue, and Radisson Blu Hotel Uppsala by the central station.

Reception and start of conference

There will be a welcoming reception in the evening of the 21st (at 18:30) at Campus English Park. The reception is free of charge for registered participants. The conference program will begin at 08.30 the 22nd of August with coffee and registration, and end around 16.30 on the 23rd of August.

Fees

There is no conference fee. Coffee/tea with snack/cookie will be served in between the talks – free of charge.

On Friday (August 23) lunch will be held at Restaurant Fazer, Segerstedthuset, Dag Hammarsköldsväg 7. (Approximately 90 SEK. This price includes a main course of your choice, salad buffet, bread and coffee/tea.)
